

Perforated and Micro-perforated Panels

Care and Maintenance Guide

Maintenance

The following actions should be undertaken every six months to ensure a consistent high-quality finish to kal'pul perforated and micro-perforated panels.

Dusting: Use a soft, dry cloth or a duster to remove any dust from the panel face. For ceiling or high-level panels, a microfiber duster on an extension pole can be handy.

Vacuuming: For any build up within the perforation holes or between panel joins, a vacuum with a brush attachment can help remove dust. Avoid using sharp or harsh connections that could scratch/ scuff the panel surfaces.

Spot Cleaning: For spots or stains, use a damp cloth with mild soap. Avoid soaking the panel, and dry it immediately with a clean, dry cloth to prevent water damage. Avoid abrasive or acidic cleaners that can damage the finish.

Care

Other measures to be considered to improve the longevity of your perforated panels.

Protect From Direct Sunlight: Direct sunlight can cause fading and drying of timber and laminate products. We recommend using blinds or curtains to reduce the impact of sunlight on timber applications where necessary.

Moisture Control: Keep indoor humidity levels stable to prevent the panels from expanding or contracting.
